- Preference will be given to applicants who are interested in careers in agriculture, viticulture, animal sciences, earth sciences, agribusiness, and/or agricultural technology.
- Preference will be given to those who are interested in working and living in Sonoma County.
- Desired personal qualities of WG Edge participants are:
 - Honesty and integrity
 - Energy, enthusiasm, motivation
 - A strong work ethic
 - Ability to work with and have empathy for others, kindness
 - Courage, willingness to take risks
 - Good communication skills and/or desire to improve communication skills
